Security Management in Hazardous Environments

3 – 7 September, 2007

This course has recently been developed by the Folke Bernadotte Academy in cooperation with the Swedish Rescue Services Agency and the Geneva Centre for Security Policy. The Course focuses on skills needed to manage safety challenges in international missions, and on aspects of the mainstreaming of risk and security management in today's hazardous environments.

Key topics are risk and security analysis and management techniques, including practical arrangements for protection and access to headquarters and buildings, relationships with subcontractors and physical security providers.

The course curriculum has been developed within the International Security Management Initiative (SMI).

Participants

Approximately 20 Swedish and international participants will train together. The participants are security managers and heads of security in headquarters and regional staffs as well as field-level security managers.

Participants should either already work in a related field or be designated for such work in the future. The course is designated for members from international and governmental organizations, the business community and nongovernmental organizations.

Cost and Location

SEK 5 550, including meals and accommodation. The course takes place on the campus of the Academy on Sandö.
